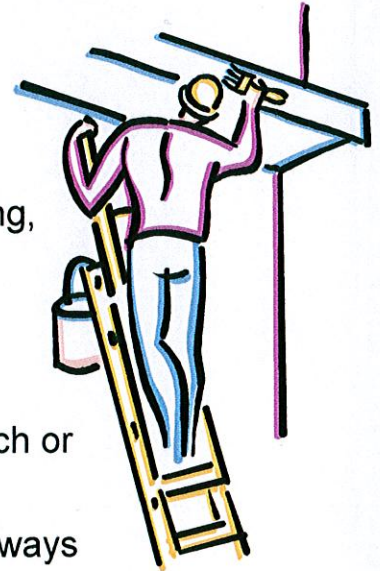




Before Requesting A Letter of Compliance, Inspect Your Property For:

- General clean-up and maintenance jobs
 - Remove debris and unsightly storage
 - Clean discolored siding, trim, fascia, gutters
 - Mend or repair broken windows, damaged siding, or landscape disrepairs
 - Weed and mulch landscape beds
 - Mow your lawn and trim all lawn perimeters
 - Cover bare soil (erosion) under decks with mulch or an approved cover
 - Repair deep cracks or broken concrete in driveways
- Rotten wood, peeling paint, damaged vinyl or wood siding
- Unapproved exterior alterations
 - Landscaping (other than foundation)
 - Patios, landings and walkways
 - Retaining walls and rock materials
 - Radon mitigation systems
 - Decks, fence, storage sheds and stains
 - Security lights, cameras, new light fixtures
 - Screening with plants or lattice
 - Play equipment including trampolines, playhouses, tot sets, soccer nets, basketball equipment (portable and permanent)
